The MPA Student


Our students are a mix of professionals from the public, business, and non-governmental sectors. PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The MPA is offered on a 2-year, part-time or 1-year, full-time basis. For non-local students from outside Hong Kong, the MPA is offered on a 1-year full-time basis only. Students are required to complete eight taught courses and one capstone project or dissertation in order to graduate. The eight courses include four compulsory courses and four courses from a list of electives.


